EVS RECEIVES \$1.3M IN ORDERS INCLUDING 50 iBAR SYSTEMS

Following Milan expo, EVS sees strong orders and increased market interest for its products

Caesarea, Israel, November 30, 2015 — Elbit Vision Systems Ltd. (OTC: EVSNF), a pioneer in the science of camera-based automatic vision inspection for textile fabrics and technical webs, announced today that it received orders totaling \$1.3 million following the successful ITMA trade show in Milan. The orders included a signed contract for 50 iBar systems for one US-based customer, which is scheduled for delivery in the early part of 2016.
